- Warm-up during announcements.

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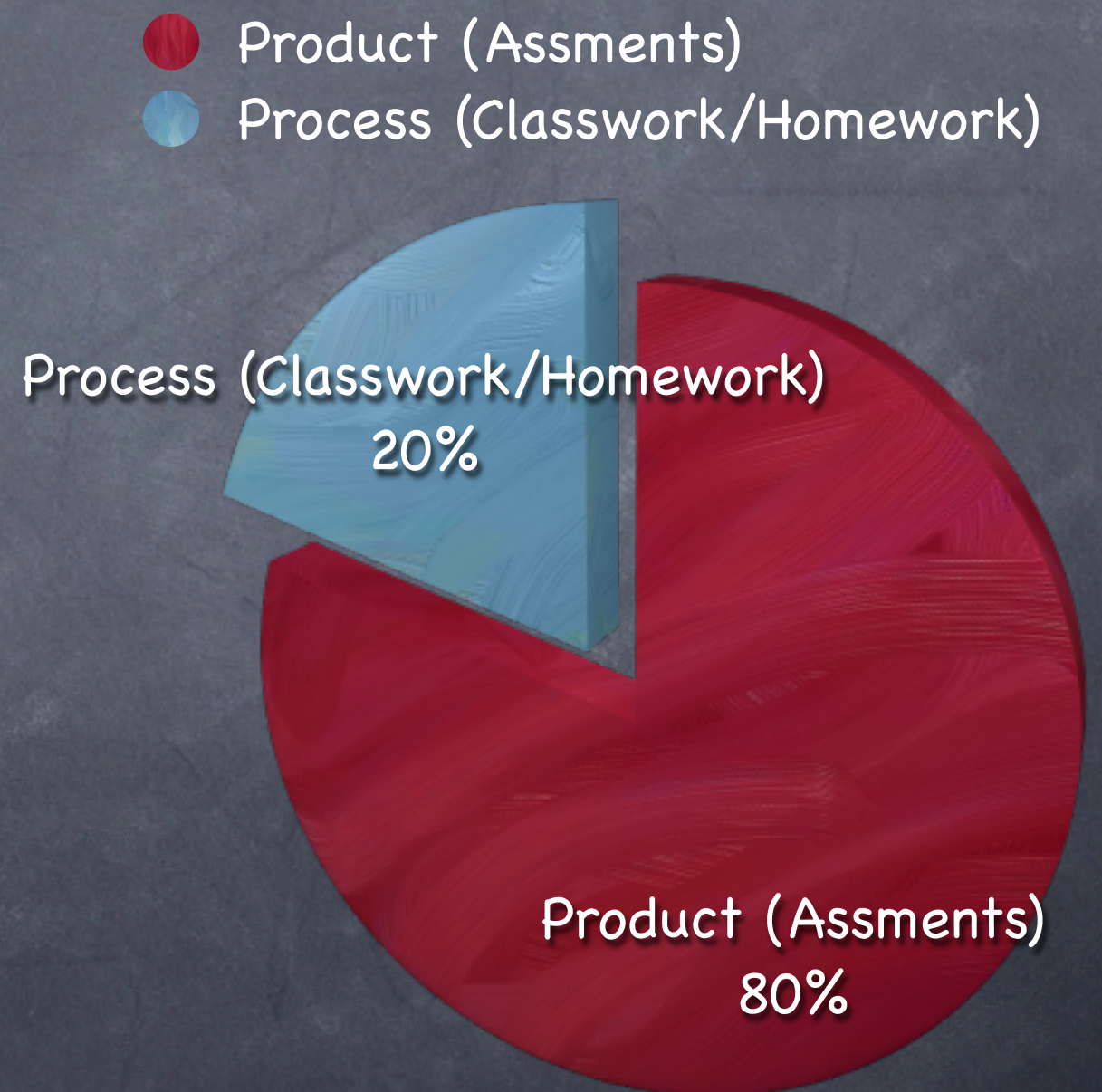
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- **Ready**: Come to class on time and ready to learn every day.
