The Horror Unit Film Project

Purpose

The purpose of this assignment is to produce a creative narrative in film form that demonstrates your mastery of the standards we have learned and practiced all year. These standards include the elements of plot and figurative language as well as literary devices and the five elements of horror. You will be graded not only on how well you incorporate these various standards into your film narrative, but also on creativity, and how well you work with your group. The rubric that will be used to score your project can be found on the back.

Assignment

You will work with a group of your choosing to create a horror film that demonstrates your knowledge and mastery of the standards listed below. Your group must be made up of at least 3 of your classmates. You may choose to include other people in the making of your film, such as using teachers, friends or relatives as actors, but remember that you are ultimately responsible for the execution and quality of your final project and you will be the one receiving a grade!

The following elements must be included in your film:

1. All of the elements of Plot (Including: Setting, protagonist, antagonist, inciting moment, suspense, at least one climax, denouement/resolution, conflict, and theme.)
2. Figurative Language elements
3. Literary Devices
4. The 5 elements of Horror

Your film should be no longer than 10 minutes long.

Before you will be given the green light to start filming, you must first have your film approved by me. To do this, your group must work together to complete a story board and plot diagram over your film and have a rough draft of your script ready.

Because this is a school project your film must be appropriate for school and can therefore can not show direct violence. You may only show the hint of violence.
